Trailblazers can explore miles of primitive hiking trails from the Hill Country to their neighborhood. Adventure seekers can rock climb their heart out at an internationally renowned climber's canyon or race along a world-class BMX track.

Water lovers can windsurf on the clear waters of Lake Travis, or soak up the sun at a lakeside beach. Sports enthusiasts can have a play day at their favorite athletic field. Whatever your thing is, enjoy an entire day in the beautiful outdoors.



TRAVIS COUNTY PARKS

1 Allen Park

6413 Westside Drive, Austin

10 acres, short hiking trails, picnic tables

2 Arkansas Bend Park

16900 Cherry Lane, Lago Vista

323 acres, fishing, camping (with showers at campsite), multi-use trails, several shaded picnic tables and a playground, plus lake access via two boat ramps and a courtesy dock

3 Barkley Meadows Park

4529 South SH 130, Del Valle

256 acres, fishing in Onion Creek, "catch-and-release" fishing in Berdoll Pond, kayaking, hike-and-bike trail, playground, barbecue grills, shaded picnic tables, and a covered shelter that can be reserved

4 Ben E. Fisher Park

600 West Carrie Manor Street, Manor

6 acres, two basketball courts, sand volleyball court, playground and a covered shelter that can be reserved

5 Bob Wentz Park

7144 Comanche Trail, Austin

211 acres, windsurfing, swimming, boating, non-motorized boat ramp, sailing, scuba diving, sand volleyball courts, barbecue grills and pavilion that can be reserved

6 Cypress Creek Park

13601 Bullick Hollow Road, Austin

15 acres, boat ramp, boating, fishing, and picnic tables with barbecue grills

7 Del Valle Sports Complex

3614 FM 973, Del Valle

12 acres, softball fields and a shelter that can be reserved

8 East Metropolitan Park

18706 Blake Manor Road, Manor

273 acres, 18-hole disc golf course, soccer fields, sand volleyball courts, baseball fields, softball field, playgrounds, fishing ponds, picnic areas, covered pavilion by reservation, plus a swimming pool and wading pool area

9 Fritz Hughes Park

3100 Fritz Hughes Park Road, Austin

5 acres, lake access, basketball, barbecue grills, picnic tables and playground

10 Hamilton Pool Preserve

24300 Hamilton Pool Road, Dripping Springs

232 acres, reservations are required to hike the trails and picnic

11 Hippy Hollow Park

7000 Comanche Trail, Austin

109 acres, sunbathing, 18 years and older clothing-optional swimming, multi-use trails

12 Little Webberville Park

910 Water Street, Webberville

6 acres, river access, boat ramp, barbecue grills and playground

13 Loop 360 Boat Ramp

5019 Capital of Texas Highway North, Austin
3 acres, three-lane boat ramp, lake access

14 Mansfield Dam Park

4370 Mansfield Dam Park Road, Austin
71 acres, boat ramp, lake access, scuba diving, fishing, multi-use trails, playground, covered shelters, barbecue grills, picnic tables, camping, and a pavilion by reservation

15 *Mary Quinlan Park*

5.8 acres, boat ramp, lake access, basketball court, picnic tables and barbecue grills

16 Northeast Metropolitan Park

420 acres, soccer fields, baseball fields, multi-use fields, tennis courts, pickleball, cricket field, BMX racetrack, skatepark, basketball court, multi-use paved trails, playgrounds, group shelters, picnic tables, barbecue grills and a splash pad

17 Pace Bend Park

2805 Pace Bend Road North, Spicewood
1,368 acres, camping, lake access, boat ramps, fishing,
multi-use trails, picnic tables, barbecue grills, plus RV
dump station and mountain biking

18 Reimers Ranch Park

23610 Hamilton Pool Road, Dripping Springs
2,427 acres, rock climbing, multi-use trails, mountain bike flow trail, river access, fishing, swimming and an astronomical observatory (reservations required)

19 Richard Moya Park

10001 Burleson Road, Austin
92 acres, multi-use fields, sand volleyball courts,
playgrounds, multi-use trails, barbecue grills, picnic tables,
shelters by reservation



20 Sandy Creek Park

9500 Lime Creek Road, Leander
92 acres, boat ramp, lake access, camping, bird watching
and nature walks, barbecue grills and picnic tables

21 Selma Hughes Park

11921 Selma Hughes Park Road, Austin
5 acres, lake access, barbecue grills and picnic tables

22 Southeast Metropolitan Park

299 acres, “catch-and-release” fishing pier, baseball fields, basketball court, soccer fields, softball fields, multi-use paved trails, primitive nature trail, playgrounds, picnic tables and barbecue grills

23 Tom Hughes Park

12714 Hughes Park Road, Austin
15 acres, lake access, swimming and sunbathing. Please know before you go: this park is not ADA accessible

24 Webberville Park

2305 Park Lane, Webberville
135 acres, boat ramp, river access, fishing pier, basketball court, soccer fields, sand volleyball courts, picnic tables and shelters, barbecue grills and playgrounds

25 Windmill Run Park

8100 Kirkham Drive, Austin
50 acres, picnic tables, hiking trails and playgrounds
