I am aware that I must disclose any prior felony conviction, and if so convicted, must provide proof that I have been pardoned or otherwise released from the resulting disabilities of any such final felony conviction. I am aware that knowingly providing false information on the application regarding my possible felony conviction status constitutes a Class B misdemeanor. I am a registered and qualified voter in Medina County, Texas and have resided continuously in Texas for 12 months and in Trustee District 1 of the Medina Valley Independent School District for at least the six (6) months immediately preceding the date of this Application. I further swear that the foregoing statements included in my application are in all things true and correct.”
