### Taxpayer Impact Statement

\* The tax year begins on January 1.

\*\* Katy ISD territory lies in three counties; property in the District is appraised by the Harris Central, Fort Bend Central, and Waller County Appraisal Districts. The median-valued homestead shown is the district-wide median market value of residence homesteads, calculated as the average of the median homestead values reported by the three appraisal districts, weighted by each county's share of the District's total appraised value. The estimated property tax bill is calculated on the corresponding district-wide median taxable value — \$254,749 for tax year 2025 and \$259,662 for tax year 2026 — divided by \$100 and multiplied by the tax rate. Taxable value is the value actually subject to tax: a homestead's appraised value (its market value as limited by the 10% homestead cap) less exemptions. The median-valued homestead is determined separately for each year shown and does not necessarily represent the same property in both years; a homestead whose taxable value is unchanged from 2025 would see no change in its District tax bill at the adopted rate.

\*\*\* The tax year 2026 median-valued homestead and estimated property tax bill are based on appraisal district information currently available. The 2026 total tax rate of \$1.1171, adopted by the Katy ISD Board of Trustees on September 21, 2026, reflects the 2026 Maintenance & Operations and Interest & Sinking tax rates of \$0.7271 and \$0.3900, respectively. The adopted rate does not exceed the District's 2026 voter-approval tax rate.
