## TENNIS COURT RULES POLICY for HIGHLAND KNOLLS COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION

I, Derrick Esper, Secretary of the Highland Knolls Community
Association (the "Association"), do hereby certify that at a meeting of the Board of Directors of the
Association (the "Board") duly called and held on the 14 day of December, 2011,
with at least a quorum of the board members being present and remaining throughout, and being duly
authorized to transact business, the following Tennis Court Rules Policy was duly approved by a majority
vote of the members of the Board:

**RECITALS:** 

- 1. Chapter 202 of the Texas Property Code was amended to add Section 202.006 (a) to require property owners' associations to file all dedicatory instruments in the real property records of each county in which the property to which the dedicatory instruments relate is located, and (b) A dedicatory instrument has no effect until the instrument is filed in accordance with this section.
- 2. The new law relating to dedicatory instruments becomes effective on January 1, 2012.
- 3. The Board of Directors of the Association desires to adopt rules consistent with the provisions of Section 202.006 of the Texas Property Code.

## POLICY:

It is the policy of the Association to enforce the following tennis court rules:

- (a) For residents and their guests only.
- (b) Tennis courts are available on a first-come, first-serve basis.
- (c) Tennis shoes must be worn.
- (d) One player holding a court must yield to 2 or more players.
- (e) Maximum court time is 90 minutes.
- (f) One court per family on weekends and holidays.
- (g) Hours from 8:00 A.M. to 10:30 P.M.
- (h) Courts to be used for Tennis activities only.
- (i) Strictly Prohibited:
  - 1. Skateboards, roller skates or bicycles on the courts.
  - 2. Alcoholic beverages, glass containers, or food.
  - 3. Pets, persons, especially children, other than Players
  - 4. Radios or other distracting devices.
